## **Tax Returns**

Isle of Man residents are required to complete an annual income tax return, declaring their worldwide income. This should be done no later than **6 October** following the end of the relevant tax year. In a limited number of circumstances you may not be required to complete a return every year. If your income is consistently below the limit of the personal allowance (currently £14,500), for example, your requirement to submit an annual return may be suspended.

## **Penalties**

Penalties will be charged for late submission. If you do not submit your return by the due date ( $6^{th}$  October), a £100 penalty will be payable. This increases to a second penalty of £200 if the return is still outstanding 6 months after the due date.

## Do I have to complete a return every year?

All taxpayers (with few exceptions) are required to complete and submit a tax return every year. In certain circumstances you may be suspended from the requirement to submit returns, in these cases you will receive a letter from the Income Tax Division at Government Offices advising you of this.
