

Our Winter bowling continues at the National Sports Centre on Thursday 8th January 2026 and will run for ten sessions up to Thursday 12th March 2026. (10 weeks) It is popular, and numbers are restricted. Anyone who cannot be accommodated will be put on a standby list.

• To ensure that members who wish to play regularly apply, a subscription of £40 is charged which includes the administration fee. Usually, non-refundable. Please note that the fees have remained the same as last session.

• We start on Thursday, 8th January 2026 at 2.00pm sharp to 3.30pm. Please meet at the hall by 1.45pm - weekly until Thursday 12th March 2026. We also enjoy an "cuppa" and a chat after the game • The cost to members will be a maximum of £4.00 per session payable through the £40

• We will need a minimum of 20 registered and paid-up members to ensure that the sessions can go ahead. This is because the payment for the use of the NSC centre has to be paid for before play can commence. Placement will be given to the first 25 paid enrolments.

• Trophies will be awarded to the lady and gentleman with the highest average scores over the 20 sessions. Qualifying minimum is 12 sessions. Other awards may be given depending on funds. An awards lunch will be arranged shortly after our last game to which all, including friends and family are invited.

· Bowling shoes and bowls are available in the bowling hall and are included in the fees.

· Lockers may be available through the NSC, not through the MRA.

· Our fees reflect the cost to the MRA of hiring the bowling hall, providing prizes and maintaining the trophies.
